As an academic, he has taught at all levels up to doctoral and has been active in syllabus writing and professional development programs. He advised ACARA on the development of the Australian Curriculum: History and advised QCAA on the new Senior Modern History Syllabus. Brian has authored and co-authored textbooks for school history and university social education. His most recent publications are Teaching Humanities and Social Sciences (Cengage 2017) - co-edited with Prof. Rob Gilbert – and Cambridge Modern History for Queensland (Cambridge 2019) - as lead author. Since 2002, Brian has worked independently as a curriculum adviser and writer.*

*Kathleen is an experienced primary school teacher who has coordinated HASS in her own school (Peregian Springs State School). She was a member of the original ACARA History advisory group and has worked for NGOs - Global Learning Centre and Together for Humanity.
