The RD Milns Antiquities Museum offers a range of programs for secondary school students studying the ancient world. These programs seek to connect students to the past through our world class collection of Mediterranean antiquities, and cover the areas of Ancient Egypt, Ancient Greece, and Ancient Rome.

A visit to the Antiquities Museum can be 1 to 4 hours in duration, and you can choose from a range of thematic tours and hands-on workshops, each 1 hour in length, in order to customise your experience.
