

# Frequently Asked Questions

## *QHTA State Conference 2023 - Brisbane Girls Grammar School*

### **Time and Date?**

Saturday 24 June - Registration 8.00 am. Program 8.45 am – 4.15 pm followed by wine and cheese session and gift draw

### **Venue?**

Brisbane Girls Grammar School, Gregory Tce, Brisbane – next to the Brisbane (Boys) Grammar School. Please follow signs to G Block or Gehrman Theatre

### **Public Transport?**

It is possible to get a bus or train from the City to Gregory Terrace.

### **Parking?**

Brisbane Girls Grammar School is on the left side of Gregory Terrace outbound from the City. If driving (with the school on the left), go past the Boys school and turn left down Kalinga Avenue (small street between Boys and Girls schools). Parking is available under BGGGS CLC Centre (marked A on the map below). The parking marked on the map below in red is small and mostly suited to drop off.

### **Where to go when I get there?**

Follow the banners and signs from the car park to G Block. Light refreshments and registration will be from 8.00 am to 8.45 near G Block. Delegates need to collect lanyard and name tag, a gift, a conference bag with multiple inserts, a Program, a Feedback Form and Trade Passport at the Registration desk. This is a good time to visit the trade area ground floor of G Block.

### **Will there be refreshments?**

Coffee, juice and a snack will be provided on arrival. Morning tea and lunch will be provided Ground Floor G Block. You should have noted any special dietary requirements when you registered online. Ask the service staff for your specific dietary food or check if there is a pack with your name. There will be wine or non alcoholic drinks, cheese platters and prize draw at end of the day.

### **After I register, what is the first session? When will the day end?**

In the Gehrman theatre, near G Block, at 8.45 am there will be a short introductory session, Welcome to Country, presentation of Outstanding Teacher Awards sponsored by WorldStrides, and an acknowledgement of QHTA's 60<sup>th</sup> birthday. This will immediately be followed by the Keynote Address by Emeritus Professor Henry Reynolds.

The Conference ends at 4.15 pm but will be followed by a short wine and cheese gathering and drawing of prize winners names.

### **How do I know what workshops to go to?**

There are four timeslots, each with eight (8) choices. You would have chosen your 4 workshops when registering and they would appear on the confirmation email sent at time of registering. Note that some workshops are fully booked so you need to go to the workshops you have nominated. You will also have the workshops printed on your name tag with the Room number underneath. Example 1b, with G24 underneath means you are to go to Workshop 1b Julie Hennessey's Workshop, Room G24 - located on the second floor of G block. If any room seems overcrowded, we will have to check name tags to see who should be in the room.

### **What if I need to know more about the workshop description?**

There will be a limited number of programs with workshop descriptions at the Registration Desk. The full program can also be found at [www.qhta.com.au](http://www.qhta.com.au) and is attached to this email.

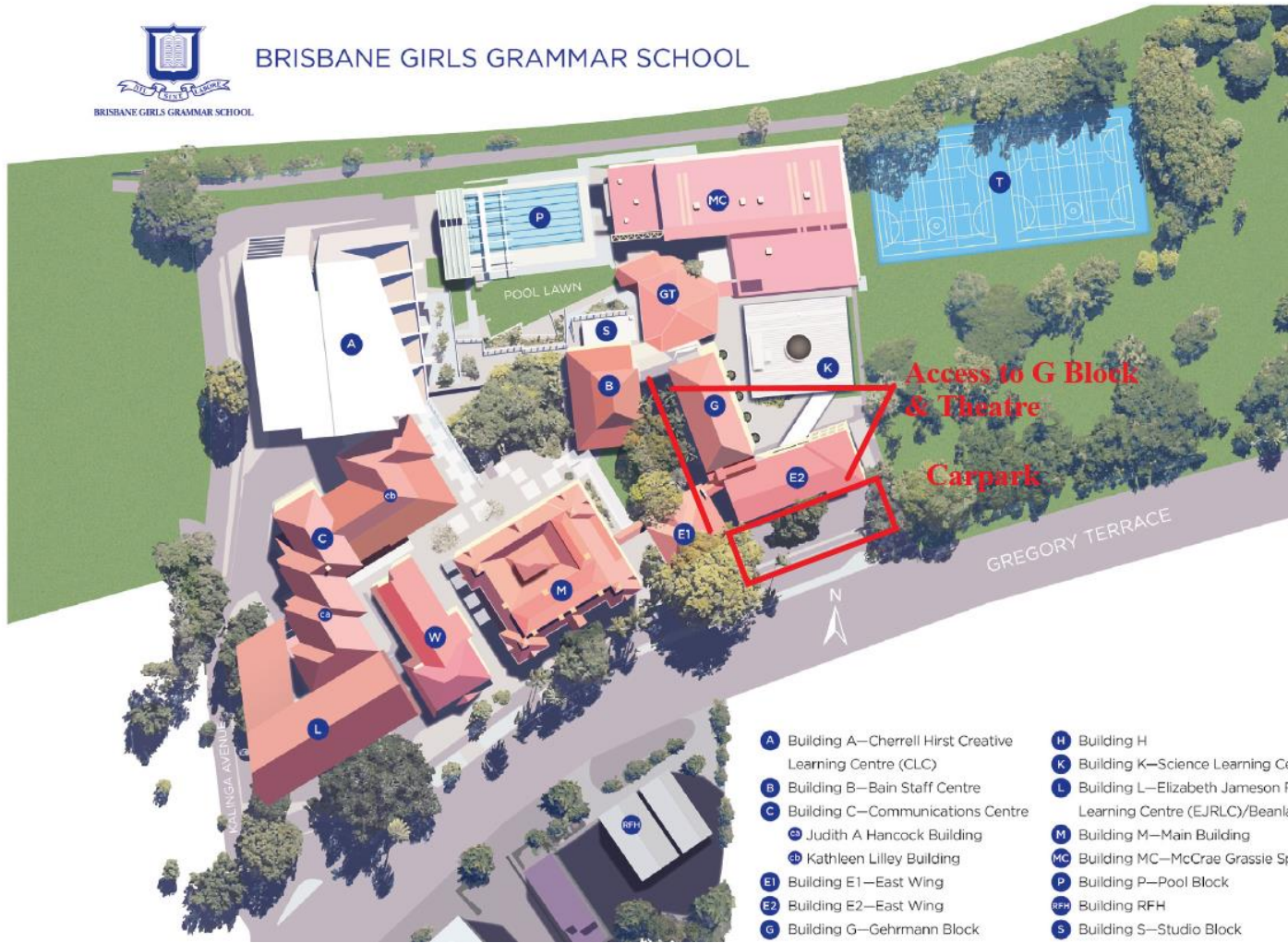
### **Will there be a trade area?**
