Time: Registration opens at 8:00am, program begins at 8:45am and final workshops conclude 4:20pm

Venue: University of the Sunshine Coast, Moreton Bay Campus (North Brisbane).

Parking:

Parking for the conference has been arranged in Car Park 1, adjacent to the UniSC Foundation Building (A1).

- On arrival, drive up to the boom gate -it should open automatically. If it does not, press the call button and a helper will assist you.
- There is also a free outdoor car park available a short walk from the Foundation Building.
- **Please do not park in the Queensland Rail car park.** This area is strictly for rail commuters and is monitored. Parking there may result in a fine.

Where do I go when I arrive?

- Follow the signs and QHTA banners from the car park to the UniSC Foundation Building entrance.
- Early arrivals (before 8:00am) will receive a voucher for a free barista-made coffee at the on-site café.

What happens at registration?

Registration opens at 8:00am. Please visit the Registration Desk to collect:

- Your name tag and lanyard
- A conference gift
- Your conference bag (including Program, Feedback Form, Trade Passport, and other inserts)

This is a great time to visit our nearby trade tables. Don't forget to get your Trade Passport stamped by each exhibitor—lucky prize winners will be drawn and announced at the beginning of the afternoon session.

You are welcome to relax on the casual theatre seating near the registration area or on the lawn outside the entrance.



Will food and drinks be provided?

Yes. Morning tea and lunch will be served, along with tea, coffee, and other beverages. Water stations are available throughout the venue.
